Certified Occupational Hand Therapist-PRN

The Certified Occupational Hand Therapist provides occupational hand therapy services to patients with impairments, developmental disabilities, functional limitations, disabilities, or changes in physical function and health status resulting from hand trauma, disease, or other causes. Individuals in this role will actively collaborate with the health care team to meet patient care goals and outcomes with exceptional service.

Education, Experience and Certification/License Requirements

Bachelor's degree from an accredited Occupational Therapy program is required. Must be certified by the National Board for Certification of Occupational Therapists and licensed by the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency. Must be certified by the American Society of Hand Therapists (ASHT) or the Hand Therapy Certification Commission (HTCC). Two to four years' of prior experience in a certified hand therapist or occupational therapist role is preferred. Must maintain current BLS certification.
