Orthopedic DME Coordinator/AT (Full-time)

The Orthopedic DME Coordinator is responsible for meeting with and providing education to post-surgical orthopedic patients in need of orthotic fittings or therapeutic equipment for recovery. Individuals in this role will interface travel to CIO surgery centers and/or the patients home on a daily basis to assist patients with proper DME usage and picking up or delivering equipment and supplied. This individual is responsible for managing and maintaining inventory for the orthopedic DME used post-surgically, interfacing with suppliers, and ensuring inventory is readily available based on scheduled surgeries and procedures. This position is responsible for maintaining and updating patient and inventory records with a high degree of accuracy in a timely and efficient manner.
