What You Will Do?

The Instrument Technician is responsible for assisting in a smooth flow of surgical cases by maintaining surgical instruments and equipment. This individual is responsible for preparing, assisting in operation of, and cleaning operating room equipment according to standardized procedures.

- Evaluate the daily case schedule to ensure the proper surgical equipment and instrument trays are prepared and ready for each procedure.
- Maintain biological's weekly.
- Check equipment for necessary preventative maintenance and notify Instrument Technician/Purchasing Coordinator when replacement equipment is needed in a timely manner.
- Perform weekly cleaning on equipment, documenting and keeping up-to-date cleaning logs.
- Examine instruments ensuring proper maintenance and assemble into standardized trays.
- Perform all phases of decontamination and processing for reuse of surgical and nursing instrumentation and/or equipment.
- Clean all equipment after surgery according to established policies and procedures.
- Fulfill all mandated operating room protocols and regulations.

What You Will Need:

Qualifications and Education Requirements

Minimum high school diploma or GED required. Completion of a Certified Operating Room Technician program required. Must maintain a certification as a Certified Operating Room Technician. At least two years' related experience required, preferably in the area of orthopedics. Additional appropriate operating room experience may be substituted for educational requirements.
