



## The Good Faith Estimate

In accordance with Indiana's House Enrolled Act (HEA 1004-2020); if a patient requests it, health care practitioners must provide a good faith estimate of the total price they will charge for a non-emergency health care service that has been ordered, scheduled or referred. Patients will not be charged for this information. The estimates are not binding; the final price may vary from the estimate based on patient's medical needs. The estimate is valid for 30 days.
